SEPTEMBER 16, 2010 was "All Local Lunch Day"

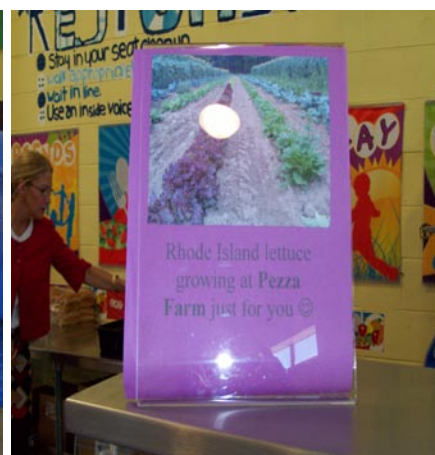
